

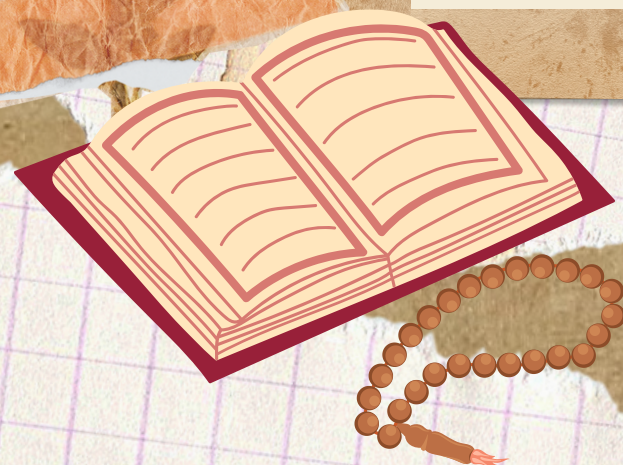

Surat An-Naba'

سورة النبأ

What's the Big Idea?

عَمَّ يَتَسَاءَلُونَ ﴿١﴾ عَنِ النَّبِإِ الْعَظِيمِ ﴿٢﴾

“About what are they asking one another? About the great news” Surat an-Naba' is named after the word (an-Naba') mentioned in its second ayah, which means (the news). Do you know, my dear kids, what does Allah want to tell us here? He wants to tell us something about the Day of Judgment.

In the Shade of the Ayat

إِنَّ يَوْمَ الْفَصْلِ كَانَ مِيقَاتًا ﴿١٧﴾

“Indeed, the Day of Judgement is an appointed “time” **يوم الفصل** is one of the names of the Day of Judgment. It is the day when life on earth will come to an end and the life of the Hereafter will begin. On that Day, Allah will give every person what he deserves – He will enter

believers to Jannah and punish the disbelievers in the Hellfire. Believing in the Day of Judgment is one of the pillars of faith, which every Muslim should believe in.

إِنَّ لِلْمُتَّقِينَ مَفَازًا ﴿٣١﴾

“Indeed, for the righteous is attainment” Allah gave good news to His servants who do good deeds that He loves them – He told them that they will be admitted to Jannah. So, every Muslim who likes to be from among the people of Jannah should do many good deeds in order to be with them.

Quran Knowledge & Action

I always choose to do good deeds – which Allah loves and commands – so that He is pleased with me and takes me to His Jannah.

In the Shade of the Ayat

وَالنَّازِعَاتِ غَرَقًا ۝١

“By those ‘angels’ stripping out ‘evil souls’ harshly,” The word النازعات means the snatchers or the extractors – it is referring to the angles who are responsible for taking out the souls from our bodies.

يَوْمَ تَرَجِفُ الرَّاكِبَةُ ۝٦

“Consider’ the Day ‘when’ the quaking Blast will come to pass,” The word راجف means to rattle or to shake – every creation will be shaking with the blow of the first trumpet.

كَأَنَّهُمْ يَوْمَ يَرَوْنَهَا لَمْ يَلْبَثُوا إِلَّا عَشِيَّةً أَوْ ضُحَاهَا ۝٤٦

“Consider’ the Day ‘when’ the quaking Blast will come to pass,” The word راجف means to rattle or to shake – every creation will be shaking with the blow of the first trumpet.

In the Shade of the Ayat

فَإِذَا جَاءَتِ الصَّاخَّةُ ﴿٣٣﴾

“So when the Deafening Noise will occur,” The word صَاخَّة means a very loud noise. This very loud blast will bring the dead to life again on the day of judgment.

يَوْمَ يَفِرُّ الْمَرْءُ مِنْ أَخِيهِ ﴿٣٤﴾

وَأُمِّهِ، وَأَبِيهِ ﴿٣٥﴾ وَصَجِبَتِهُ، وَبَنِيهِ ﴿٣٦﴾

“on that Day every person will flee from their own siblings, and ‘even’ their mother and father, and ‘even’ their spouse and children.” On the day of judgement, everyone will be in such panic that they forget about

everyone and flee in all different directions. The horror and fear of the day of Judgement makes you forget about the people nearest and dearest to you like members of their family such as your brother, father, mother, wife, and children.
