


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"When the Inevitable Event takes place," Allah is describing the day of judgment in this Ayah as inevitable, meaning that with no doubt it will happen, leaving no room for denial.



"It will debase 'some' and elevate 'others'." On the day of resurrection, people who were arrogant and disobedient are amongst the wrong-doers and they will humiliated whereas believers and righteous good-doers will be elevated.



"you will have to eat from the tree of Zaqqum" The Ayah talks about the tree of Zaqqum as punishment for the dwellers of Hellfire. It will be so terrible when it's consumed because it is a bitter and throney fruit that will neither nourish them nor taste good.

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"He makes the night enter into the day, and makes the day enter into the night, and He is All-Knowing about whatever lies in the hearts." Allah is in charge of everything including the time and all the four seasons. He is All-Aware and All-knowing of anything hidden in our hearts and our intentions, beliefs and thoughts.
