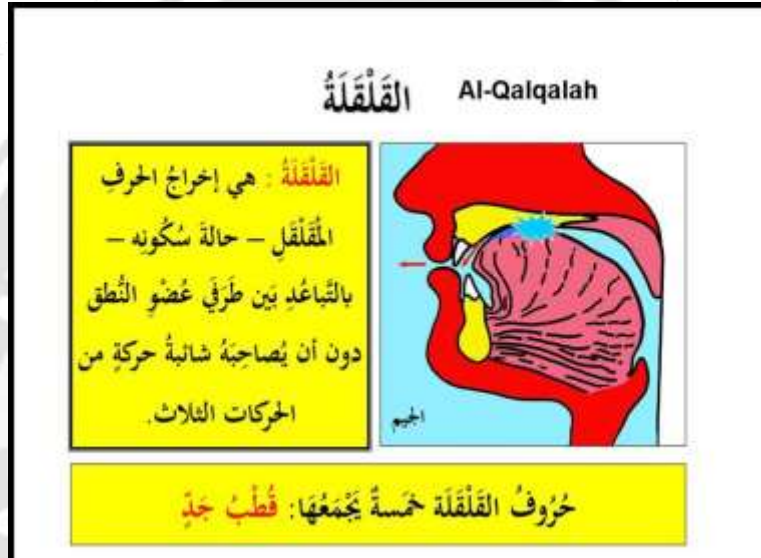

Definition of Qalqalah:

The word Qalqalah means vibration/shaking; Qalqalah is echoing the below five letters when they are in state of **sukoon**, i.e.

ق ط ب ج د

The diagram below shows what happens when we pronounce letter ج



Letters of Qalqalah:

They are collected in the word [قُطْبٌ جَدٌ]

This is cool way to never forget the letters of qalqalah©
Don't (د) be (ب) quick (ق) to (ط) jump (ج)

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Chapter Two:

Types of Qalqalah

There are two types of Qalqalah:

1. The greater qalqalah الْقَلْقَلَةُ الْكُبْرَى
2. The lesser qalqalah الْقَلْقَلَةُ الصُّغْرَى

الْقَلْقَلَةُ الصُّغْرَى The lesser qalqalah

If any of the 5 letters appear with a Sukoon in the middle of a word, we will not fully stop at that letter, a light vibration takes place:

[وَتَقَوْنَهَا]

الْقَلْقَلَةُ الْكُبْرَى The greater qalqalah

If any of the 5 letters appear with a Sukoon and **at the end of the word, and we will stop there**, then the stronger qalqalah (vibration of the last letter) occurs:

[لَمْ يَكِدْ وَلَمْ يُؤَلِّدْ]
