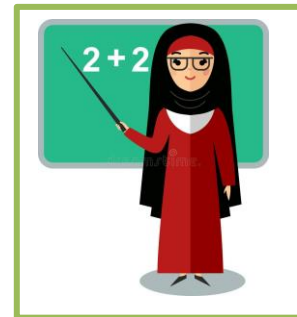

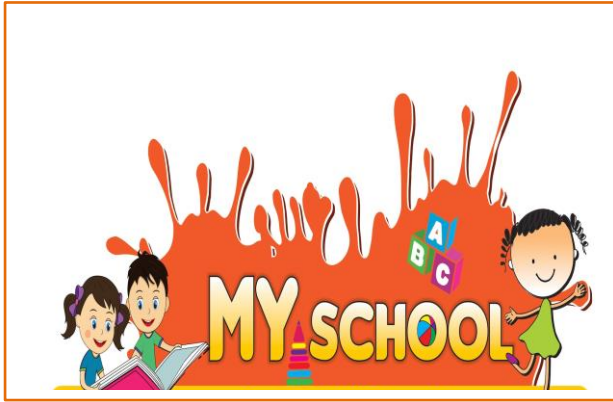


Omnia Mohamad Arabic/Islamic Teacher
