Please be advised of the following registration procedures for MIS:

Jan.13- 31 The registration portal will be open for our returning students. Priority given to Current Students at MAC Islamic Schools.

All students currently attending MAC Islamic School **need to re-register** for the 2025 - 2026 school year. Re-registration is **NOT automatic**.

Since 2012, MAC Islamic School (MIS) has thrived and developed into a leading Islamic school in Edmonton. Our families, faculty, and administration are integral parts of our school community, and we were able to expand with the addition of the junior/senior high school. MIS will continue to deliver an excellent education for our students, and we wish not only to maintain the highest educational standards, but also to exceed your expectations.

Over the past several years, we worked hard to make MIS one of the most affordable private Islamic schools across Canada, with a commitment to ensure that fees are appropriate and are supporting families as much as possible. We found a way to manage unavoidable costs through diligent financial stewardship and control of expenses. We minimized fee increases to the least possible amount while still being able to offer the quality of education that you expect and that your children deserve.

Going forward, with continued growth and expansion and rising inflation costs, a higher increase in tuition fees is necessary. We recently completed a robust financial analysis and concluded that continuing this way is no longer sustainable for the operational needs of the school in supporting its expenses. As such, we would like to provide you with as much notice as possible with the following information pertaining to an increase in tuition fees for both elementary and junior/senior high which will be implemented over a three-year period as follows:

2024/2025 School Year	<u>2025/2026 School Year</u>	2026/2027 School Year
\$3750 (1 st child)	\$4400 (1 st child)	\$4950 (1 st child)
\$3550 (2 nd child)	\$4200 (2 nd child)	\$4750 (2 nd child)
\$3350 (3 rd child)	\$4000 (3 rd child)	\$4550 (3 rd child)

Generally, the increase per child amounts to \$75/ month in 2024/2025, \$65/month in 2025/2026 and \$55/month in 2026/2027. These increases are essential for the following developments will undoubtedly further enable MIS to ultimately provide the best educational experience for our students:

- sustain the operational costs of the schools
- attract and retain qualified and specialized teaching staff by aligning MIS teachers' salaries to market
- provide service offerings which will increase enrollment in junior/senior high
- fund the expansion of enriching programming such as STEAM, Athletics, and Humanities

MIS is immensely grateful for your continued support, and we look forward to uniting our partnership in building the best educational future for your children.
