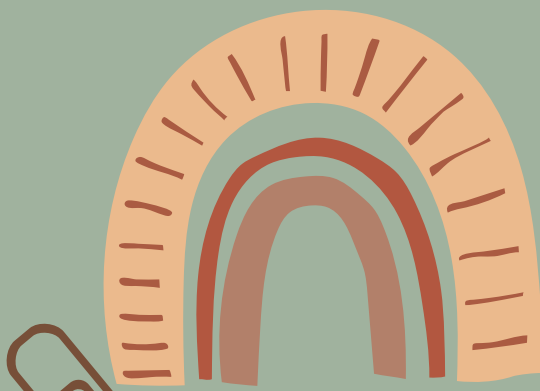


## WELCOMING WINTER

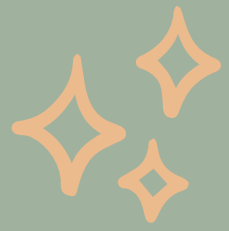
Dressing properly is the key to stay warm and active during the winter season. We advise our students to bundle up on the winter gear like warm jackets, mittens and winter boots.

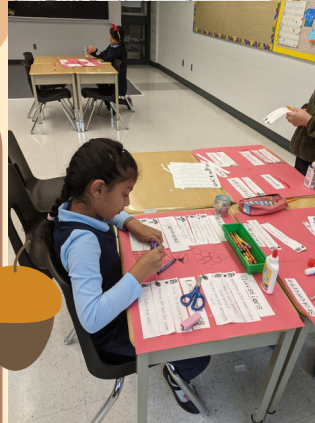

## READING COMPETITION: NOV 4

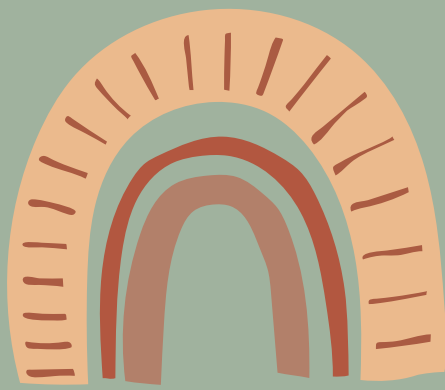
