Registration Information 2021-2022 School Year

Olive Grove High School aims to provide an engaging and challenging curriculum with Ontario Certified Teachers and small class sizes. For admission to OGHS, please take note of the following:

- All applicants are required to sign up on our online waitlist system (\$50 waitlist fee applies).
- Our admission office will initiate a contact via email and/or phone call for candidates to hand in their application packages.
- Application fee, including assessment test and interview, is due at the time of application, and is non-refundable
 - \$200 for OGMS students
 - \$300 for new non-OGMS students
- Assessment tests will be administered to all applicants covering Math/Language Arts/Islamic Studies.
- Student interviews will be conducted on a following date for shortlisted candidates as part of the assessment process.
- Acceptance or decline letters will be sent out, via email within 2 weeks from the assessment date.
- If a spot is offered to a student and declined, then student's name will be removed from the waitlist
- All students have to meet the following:
 - o academic expectations (minimum B average) for Term 2 in Grade 8
 - strong learning skills for Term 2 in Grade 8 and
 - o display excellent behaviour verified by the reference letters
 - one from Grade 8 Language Arts/Math/Science teacher and
 - one from Grade 8 Arabic/Quran/Islamic Studies teacher
- Priority for admission is given to Olive Grove Middle School graduates

Tuition Fees: \$9100¹ for the academic year which includes:

- Workbooks & Printed materials
- Enrichlt! field trips, workshops and activities in the GTA
- Yearbook
- Student ID cards

<u>Capital Fees (Invest OGS)</u>: \$3500 one-time fee per family is required to be paid in the first year of enrollment

<u>Chromebook Fees</u>: \$150 "Chromebook for every student" rental fee. Students can purchase their own Chromebook device from the school for \$500, or on their own. For those who have their own Chromebook, they are required to pay \$50 per year provisioning and licensing fee.

Scholarship: will be available for candidates who apply based on academic and/or behavioural merit ranging from \$500 - \$1500 per year per student.

<u>Subsidy</u>: is available for qualified families through MAC Education Fund.

Financial Aid:

Partial bursaries are available to any family, based on financial need, as determined by the MAC Education Fund (MEF) committee. Please check our website for more information and application form. MEF recipient families are exempt from the InvestOGS capital fee.

Sibling Discount

Families with multiple siblings are eligible for a 10% loyalty discount applied to the lowest fee for all siblings.

Chromebook Fee

For students in Grade 6 and up, parents can either pay an annual **\$150** fee for leasing a dedicated Chromebook device or pay **\$500** to purchase a new device from OGS. Those who prefer to bring their own Chromebook devices, they need to have them provisioned by the school and pay **\$50** annual fee for licensing and provisioning.

Scholarship for High School Students

Annual scholarships of an amount between \$500-\$1500 are available to be awarded to High School students based on their academic and behavioural merits.

Tax Deductions

A donation receipt will be issued for a portion of the tuition fees in accordance with the Canada Revenue Agency guidelines.

We encourage our parents who have the means to increase their contribution, beyond the tuition fees, and donate generously to help us sustain and evolve our healthy operation.

¹ Can be paid by monthly installments. Parents for newly enrolled students have to pay the capital fee during the first year.

² Tuition fee is paid over 10 equal monthly installments (Aug to May for elementary students and Jul to Apr for high school students).
