ENRICHIT!

- OGHS teams participated in MoHack Health Quest at Mohawk College and were runner-ups in the competition
- OGHS students won silver & bronze in the University of Waterloo, Senior Financial Literacy Competition
- 90 OGHS students participated and 6 medalled at DECA Regionals and competed at the Provincials
- A team of students gave outstanding performances at the 4th Annual MAC Convention
- Our Grade 11 student received an Honourable Mention award at the University of Toronto Model United Nations (UTMUN), debate training and competition
- Two Grade 11 students represented Canada in the FIRST Robotics Competition; a world-wide competition held in Houston

ACADEMICS

- Grade 10 student won first place in the CMU CS Academy competition for Python coding

- For World Math Day Mathletics, OGHS students got 5th place across Canada

ATHLETICS

- Boys came second in their division at Inter-Islamic School Cross Country Run
- Girls' Basketball team won their division in ROPSSAA & participated in OFSSAA, being only 1 of 18 schools in tier 1 to make it to the provincials
- Both Girls' & Boys' teams won GOLD at the Inter-Islamic Volleyball Tournament
- Girls' Volleyball team won their ROPSSAA game against St. Joseph Catholic School
- Girls' Basketball team won GOLD both in the Inter-Islamic School Basketball Tournament as well as at MIST
- Boys' team won SILVER and Girls' won BRONZE in the Inter-Islamic School Soccer Tournament
